Casual Support Workers

Support Workers help individuals with disabilities throughout their day-to-day activities, as well as assisting them to live full lives within the community. CLTB provides support based on the individuals needs and interests. Your role in this position will vary depending on the person's needs and could include assisting with hygiene and personal care, housekeeping, meal preparation, medication administration, and financial management, as well as providing experiences and opportunities that fit the interests and goals of the person you support. CLTB envisions a world where people with disabilities are able to live fulfilling lives in their communities and feel included. As a Support Worker you will play an essential role in fulfilling this vision.



Casual TAY (Youth) Support Workers

Support Workers for Transitional Aged Youth (TAY) will support young adults aged 18+ in a variety of settings, supporting them to live the lives they choose. CLTB provides support for people with developmental disabilities, and some individuals also experience a mental health condition and/or addiction. We are looking for people who can provide support that is free of personal bias. You will be a support worker, mentor, and role model as you help young adults develop life skills such as household care, meal preparation, and financial planning. You will help them to develop decision making skills, work on harm reduction strategies, and help them cope with emotional crises. TAY Support Workers also help these young adults to develop their community connections and social skills so that they may confidently participate as a member of the community. Anyone who starts to live independently as an adult will have many new experiences and responsibilities, and your role in this position will be to guide these individuals through this process
