TOPIC:

Environmental/ Physical Requirements for Residential Settings

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POLICY:

As defined in the Services and Supports to promote the Social Inclusion of Persons with Developmental Disabilities Act, 2008, every intensive support residence and supported group living residence will at the very least, achieve the physical/environmental requirements outlined in Ontario Regulation 299/10 Quality Assurance Measure.



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DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this policy we are adapting the following definitions from the *Services* and *Supports to Promote the Social Inclusion of Persons with Developmental Disabilities Act, 2008*:

Intensive support residence means a staff-supported residence operated by a service agency,

- (a) in which one or two persons with developmental disabilities reside, and
- (b) in which each resident requires and receives intensive support that meets the prescribed requirements;

Supported group living residence means a staff-supported residence operated by a service agency, in which three or more persons with developmental disabilities reside and receive services and supports from the agency.

PROCEDURE:

1. All intensive support residences and supported group living residences shall:

Safe and Sanitary environments:

- Ensure that any outside area is maintained in a safe and sanitary condition.
- Have an inside common area, maintained in a safe and sanitary condition.
- Ensure that all exits in the home are clear and unobstructed.
- Ensure that appliances and furnishings in the home are clean and are in good condition and working order.
- Ensure that hazardous household products are stored and used safely within the home.

Temperature Control:

 Have an internal minimum temperature of 20 degrees Celsius that is maintained from October 1st to May 31st.



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- Ensure that any portable electric heaters used shall meet CSA approval standards.
- Ensure that the home has at least one air conditioned room for extreme heat days.
- Ensure that the cooling room is maintained at a humidex level below 35 degrees Celsius at all times.

Water:

- Ensure that all homes are connected to the Municipal water treatment system. Any adverse water quality must be reported as a Serious Occurrence to M.C.S.S.
- Ensure a mixing valve is installed at the hot water heater or at the tap. Water temperature must be checked every morning and the temperature must be recorded on the *CLTB Daily Water Temperature Checks* form. Water temperature must be no higher than 49 degrees Celsius.

Sleeping Environments:

- Ensure that each person has a bed of the appropriate size, a suitable mattress, and bedding that is appropriate to the weather.
- Ensure that the bedroom for each person has appropriate individual furniture and clothing storage.
- Ensure that the bedroom for each person provides sufficient space to keep their personal possessions and to pursue hobbies and interests without unwanted or unwarranted intrusion from others.
- Ensure that the bedroom for each person has an exterior window, screen, and window coverings.
