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## **POLICY**

It is the policy of Community Living Thunder Bay that the rights of workers under the Occupational Health and Safety Act be communicated to employees.

### **PURPOSE**

To ensure that all employees are aware of their rights under the Occupational Health and Safety Act.

### **RESPONSIBILITY**

It is the responsibility of the Joint Occupational Health and Safety Committee to ensure employees' rights are communicated to them.



**GENERAL MANUAL PROCEDURE** 

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**TOPIC: Worker Rights** 

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## **PROCEDURE:**

- 1. At the time of orientation the Joint Occupational Health and Safety Committee will ensure that the following rights are communicated to employees:
  - Right to know about workplace health and safety hazards
  - Right to participate in making recommendations on health and safety issues
  - Right to refuse work if they believe it endangers health and safety
  - The right to refuse unsafe work may be limited if:
    - A circumstance is inherent in the worker's work or is a normal condition of the worker's employment 43(1)(a)

or

 When the worker's refusal to work would directly endanger the life, health or safety of another person 43(1)(b)
