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POLICY

It is the policy of Community Living Thunder Bay to provide a method for employee input into the health and safety of the entire workplace.

PURPOSE

To ensure all employees have a voice in decisions pertaining to health and safety.

RESPONSIBILITY

It is the responsibility of all employees to adhere to this policy.



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GENERAL MANUAL PROCEDURE

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PROCEDURE:

- Each service area of the Agency will endeavour to have a representative on the Joint 1. Occupational Health and Safety Committee.
- Any employee who wants to provide input into decisions of the Joint Occupational Health 2. and Safety Committee can do so by presenting their input/concerns in writing to their representative or to any other member of the committee. Employees can also request that they make a verbal presentation to the committee.
- Employees may forward written documentation to the Co-Chairs for placement on the 3. agenda.
- All concerns/input should provide as much detail as possible. 4.
- The committee will review the input/concern and provide written feedback to the 5. employee.
